Arts

- **Oxford Music Online and Oxford Art Online**

Oxford's two handbooks contain edited dictionaries and bibliographies in their respective fields.

- **IMSLP/Petrucci Music Library**

The largest freely available virtual sheet music collection.

Multidisciplinary

- **Academic Search Complete**

It contains more than 8,800 full text, mostly peer-reviewed journals.

- **Akadémiai Journals**

Collection of more than 60 peer-reviewed international e-journals which represent the new results of natural sciences and social sciences.

- **EBSCOhost**

It contains 10 databases with access to thousands of journals, full-text content, and abstracts of various topics.

- **ProQuest Central**

Provides access to millions of publications of about 18,000 scientific journals.

- **Wiley**

A database covering of nearly 1,500 full-text journals in the areas of health, natural sciences and social sciences.

- **ScienceDirect**

Elsevier's full-text database provides full-text access to the texts of 3,800 of the most respected scientific journals. Includes the Cell Press and the Lancet journal packages.

- **Scopus**

Abstract and citation database of Elsevier. Best suited for science metrics and exploring author references.

- **SpringerLink**

The full-text database outstanding in the fields of technology, nature and medicine, but other disciplines are also represented in English and German.

- **Web of Science**

Reference and bibliographic database. Its multidisciplinary materials cover all disciplines. It allows to do researches regarding to science metrics and discover the author references.

- **Journal Citation Reports (JCR)**

Collects the reference data of the world's leading scientific journals. The science metric indicators include the impact factor (IF) of journals.

- **Cambridge University Press – Full Collection**

The journals cover almost all disciplines, from the humanities and social sciences to the natural and applied sciences.

- **Oxford University Press - Full Collection**

Its journals are outstanding primarily in humanities, but also in social and natural sciences, law and medicine.

- **Taylor and Francis**

The publications cover the fields of humanities, medicine, engineering, social and natural sciences, with more than 2,500 journals.

- **Sage Journals – Premier Package**

More than 1100 journals published by Sage since 1999 are available in the database. The publications cover all scientific disciplines - with a particular focus on natural science journals.

E-books, textbooks

- **Akadémiai Dictionaries**

The full material of English dictionaries are available.

- **Springer Nature**

It contains 2500 English science books.

- **LWW (Lippincott Williams & Wilkins)**

There are currently 1100 medical e-books available with full text.

- **ScienceDirect**

1000 publications covering a wide range of disciplines.

Access to the databases from home!

At the top of the page you can see EBSCO Discovery Service search box, which provides access to subscribed scientific databases, e-journals of the University, and the library catalog at once.

The library provides a proxy service for every university citizen to access subscribed content from home. This requires a valid library card. The access can be activated by supplying the barcode number on the back of the card along with the associated password.

In addition to the proxy, some databases are also available with so-called EduID identification (Neptun / EHA code required), details can also be found in the site above.

Our top databases

Social sciences

• Jstor

It contains more than 1000 journals. The database is retrospective: the full texts of the journals are included in the database only after 3–5 years of publication.

• De Gruyter Journals - Social Sciences and Humanities Package

De Gruyter's journal database is an online collection of peer-reviewed journals. The multidisciplinary package provides full-text access to studies from 1995 to the present.

• Project MUSE - Humanities Collection

The humanities and social sciences database mainly contains full-text journals and book chapters from university presses.

Natural sciences

• American Chemical Society (ACS)

It contains over 50 chemical journals with full text access.

• MathSciNet

A mathematical science database that incorporates bibliographic data and abstracts.

• Nature

Nature journals cover a wide range of medical and natural sciences, including the most respected and commonly referred studies.

• SciFinder Discovery Platform

Bibliographic database containing materials and reaction descriptions, alongside with abstracts of the scientific literature. To use it, you will have to register (instructions on the database portals' infofile).

Medicine

• LW (Lippincott Williams & Wilkins)

A total of 250 journals and 100 ebooks can be reached with full text. The collection covers all areas of medical science.

• UpToDate

Used in many countries as an evidence-based clinical decision support system. Summarizes the results of each symptom and medication. It can be used in general medical work to identify the disease and determine the proper treatment.

• Embase

A biomedical database containing millions of bibliographic records from 1947 to the present; some of them are available in full text.

• PubMed

The most popular medical database containing millions of bibliographic records. Most of the items have a link to the full text. The database is available from anywhere.

• Karger

Consisting of more than 100 e-journals. The publications focus primarily on clinical research.

• Cochrane Library

It contains systematic reviews, controlled trials, protocols and clinical answers on the field of evidence-based medicine.

• BMJ Journals

Provides access to the British Medical Journal interface and a further 26 journals.

Business and economics

• Statista

The global coverage database grants access to statistics and studies to business, financial, political, media and other data. Data, graphs can be exported in several formats.

• Business Source Premier

Journals are available with full text; in addition, business reports and country reviews are included in the database.

• EconLit Fulltext

It contains the data of the economic journals and books of the past 120 years. In addition to the bibliography, the articles of hundreds of journals are available in full text

• EMIS

The Emerging Markets Information Service provides comprehensive insight into the emerging economies of Central and South-Eastern Europe at company, sector and country level. In addition to reports and forecasts, it can also monitor the political-economic press.

• Emerald Premier journals

The full text of Emerald's journals is available. It covers mainly specific fields of economics and wide range of management and other professional topics in the social and technical sciences.

• Jstor Business & Economics Collection

It contains nearly 250 leading journals in economics. The database is retrospective; the full text of the journals is included in the database only after 3–5 years of publication.

Engineering databases

• IEEE Electronic Library

Provides access to the literature of electrical engineering, electronics and information technology in journals, conferences and patents.

Law

• HeinOnline

The database contains full-text legal science journals and documents.
