About the library

The common library of the two faculties - with the reconstruction of the Rákóczi street complex - was opened in September 2003 combining the two previously separate faculty libraries. The library has operated under the name of University of Pécs Library of the Faculties of Law and Economics until March 2007 then it took the Pécs resident law scholar Ferenc Benedek's name and moved into the third floor of the Centre for Learning in 2010. The library primarily serves the education and research at the two aforementioned faculties. In addition to the traditional services - loan, automated loan, information, interlibrary loan and reprographics - it pays great attention to content delivery and vocational information as well as to support the scientific activities of teachers, researchers and students.

European Documentation Centre

The official publications of the European Union (statistics, reports, educational brochures published by The Publications Office of the European Union) and scientific publishers' professional EU themed Hungarian and English books form the core of the 9000 document large collection. The official website of the EU and the databases subscribed by the University of Law are also accessible on the four reader's computer of the Documentation Centre.

The heritage of Georg Brunner

The 5000-volume reference library of Professor Georg Brunner was donated by his widow Ursula Brunner to the Faculty of Law in 2003. The publications that are part of the collection analyse the legal systems of Eastern European countries and the issues of the constitutional concept- and the separation of powers doctrine within the framework of Legal Philosophy and Constitutional Law. Researchers can find useful materials here to examine the European political systems, the Eastern European regime changes, minority issues and the German-German relations.

World Bank Collection

The Washington-based World Bank has sent its publications as a gift to the library of the University of Pécs from 1996 to 2008. The collection contains books related to international economic relations, economic development, economic sociology, developing countries and money matters furthermore various reports and studies.

Terminology Documentation Centre

The Terminology Documentation Centre - the first in Hungary - was created in 2009 with the main tasks of collecting national and international terminology themed publications to ensure their accessibility and to develop the computer background.
